

## Appendix 2: Vendor Definitions

<b>Type of Vendor</b>	<b>Definition</b>
Almacen	Convenience store where the clerk primarily serves the client. The majority of the store's goods are behind the counter. Clients are only allowed to serve themselves a limited number of goods such as bottled beverages, prepackaged snacks or a small variety of fresh fruits.
Minimarkets	Store that is primarily a self-service. Majority of the store's goods are in front of the counter. Minimarkets may have a small bakery and a larger variety of goods than an Almacen. Minimarkets have two or less cash registers.
Kiosks	Small roadside retailers some are small units on wheels. Vendors mainly sell cigarettes by the pack and ready-to-drink beverages and small-prepackaged snacks, gum and lottery tickets. Some may also sell magazines and newspapers.
Supermarket	Store that sells produce, fresh meat, prepared, packaged, frozen and canned food. Supermarkets also sell bottled beverages, alcohol and packaged snacks. Store has three or more cash registers.
